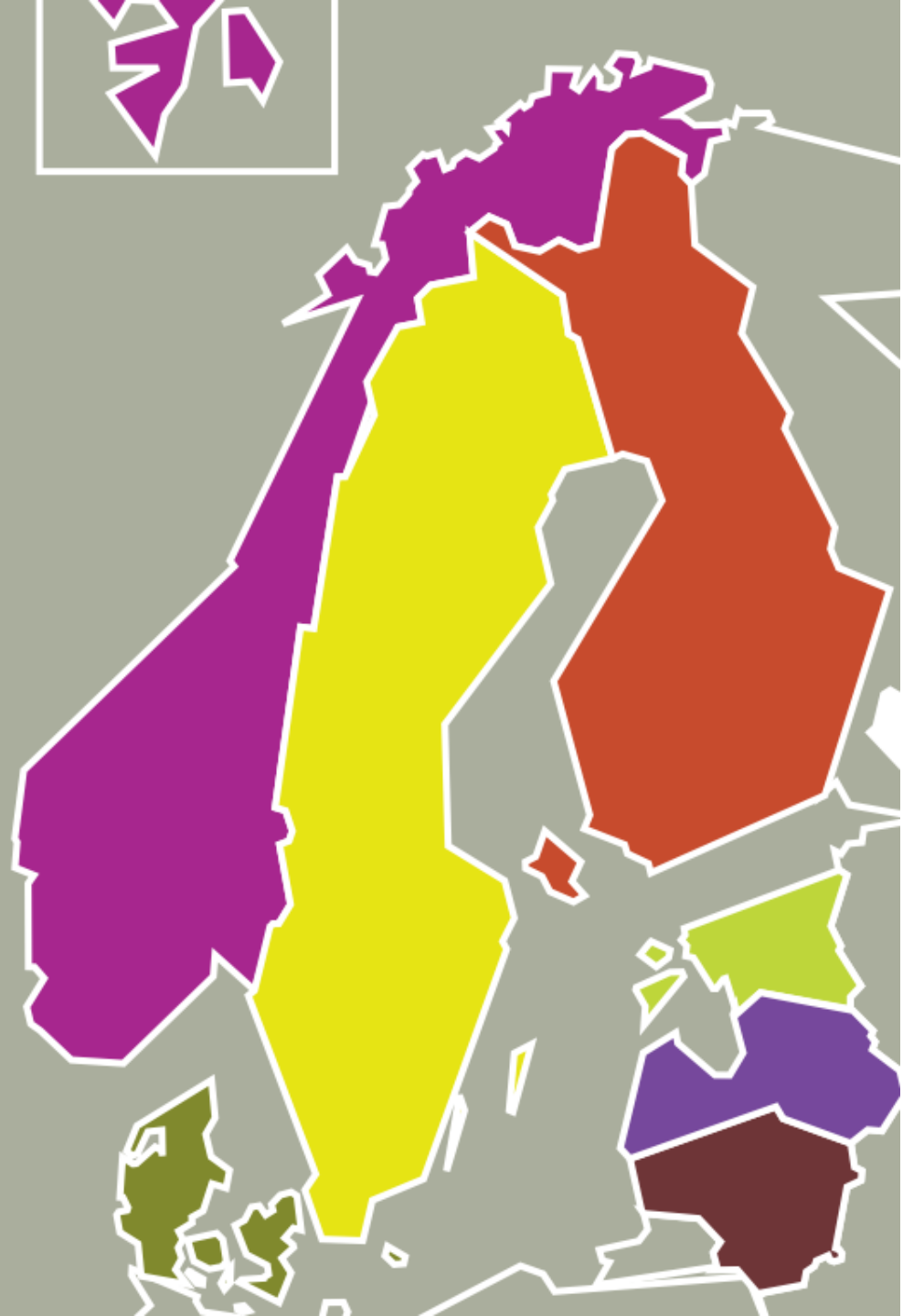

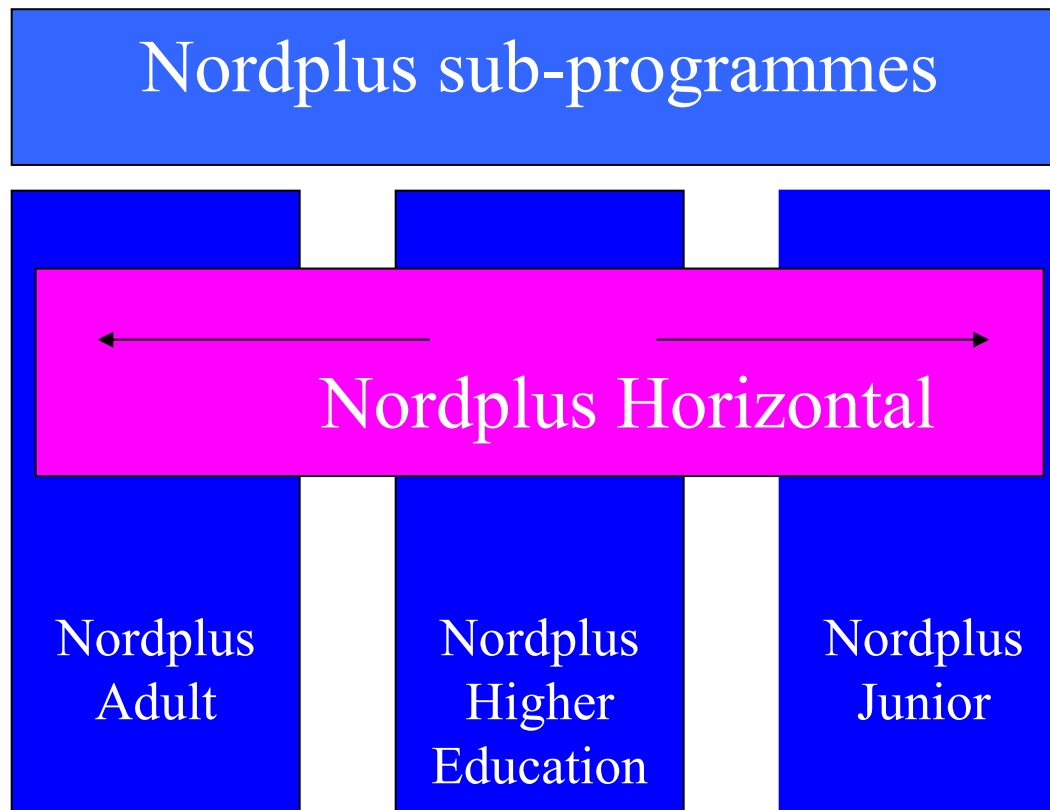

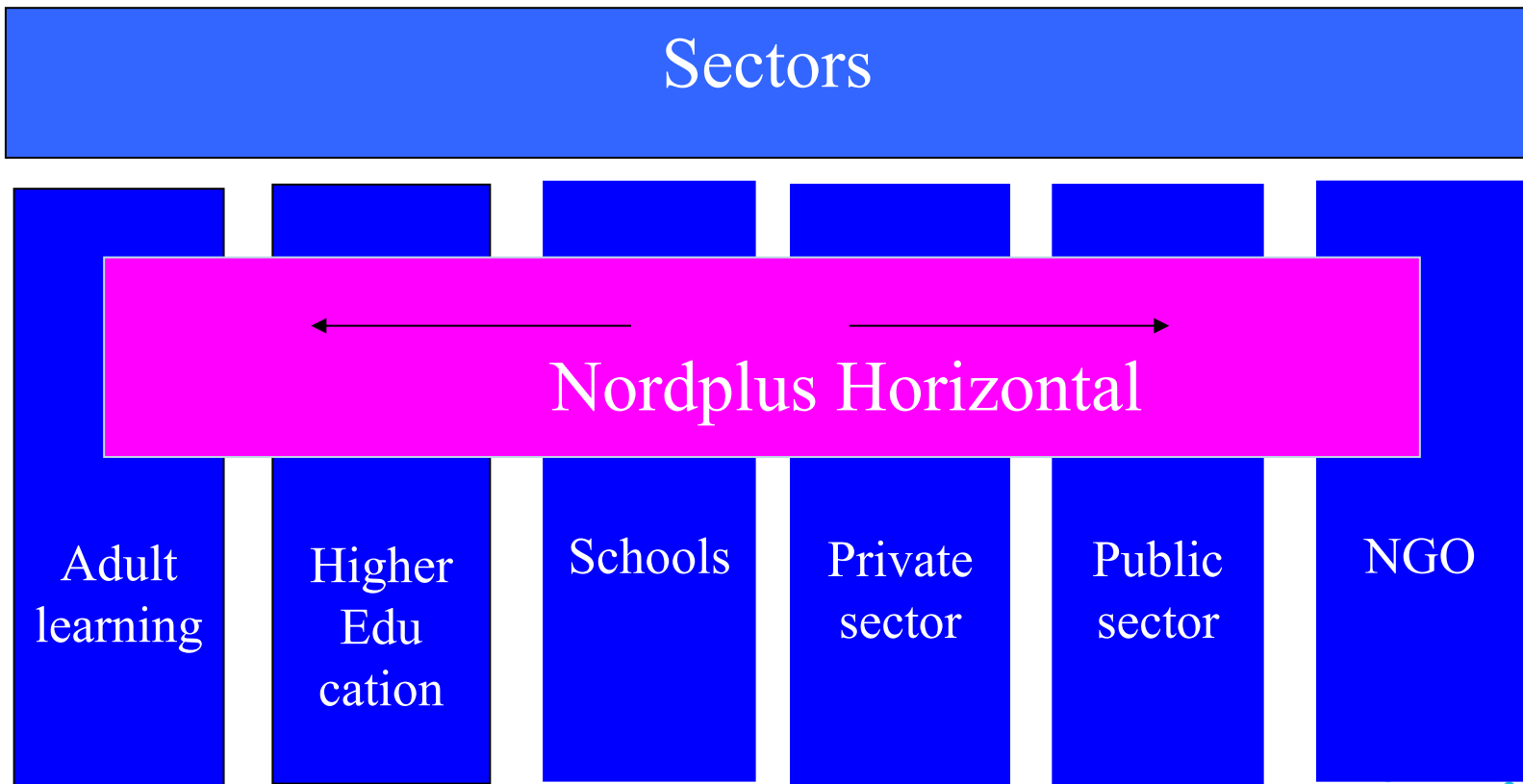
What is Nordplus Horizontal?

- is a cross-sector innovation in the Nordplus programme
- aims to link the various sector program and provide new and extended partnership opportunities
- and shall support innovative projects spanning traditional categories and sectors, which can tackle new, different, broader or more complex issues and challenges

Nordplus Horizontal

- Annual budget for Nordplus Horizontal is approximately EUR 1 mill.
- Support 20-25 projects each year
- Grants varies from EUR 10 000 – 100 000, depending of the size of the project (number of institutions and activities) and duration (1-3 years).

Nordplus Horizontal

Activities:

- the programme supports cross-sectoral projects and network activities that are horizontal and innovative in a variety of ways
- it can be horizontal as regards **participants, partners, sectors, methods, issues, products and results and dissemination potential**
- it can be activities that, in a cross-sectoral way, build and expand on previous Nordplus-supported networks and projects, e.g. activities that aiming to analyse, compare, disseminate and exploit result from those networks and projects more widely

Nordplus Horizontal

Examples of activities:

- workshops, seminars and conferences
- studies and analyses
- statistics projects
- projects aiming to exploit the results of educational research
- production of materials for innovative language training, teaching and translation
- publication, distribution and exchange of results and experiences in education

Nordplus Horizontal

Who is eligible?

- institutions, organisations and companies/enterprises that work mostly in the education and lifelong learning sectors in the eight participating countries
- project and network activities should involve minimum 2 sectors and a minimum of 3 partners from 3 different Nordplus countries
- The programme does not support individual mobility. The programme only support mobility cost when connected to project and network activities.
- Nordplus Horizontal can cover up to 50 % of the total costs. The programme does not support salary, but time spent on the project can be a part of the own contribution.

Nordplus Horizontal

What is a good applicaton?

- describe objectives and expected outcome
- describe the activities
- describe the distribution of tasks and responsibilities between partners
- be well argued according to the programme objectives
- define the added value of the project for partners and others
- have a realistic budget in relation to the funds available
- define the targets for disseminating the results
- demonstrate integration of the activities in the respective organisations

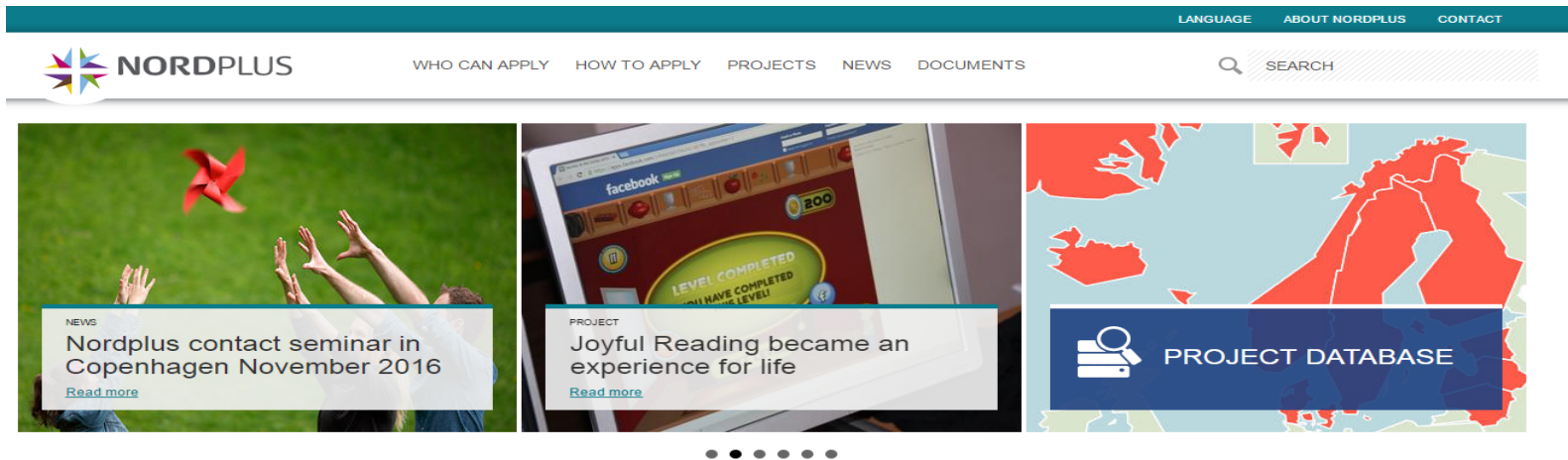
